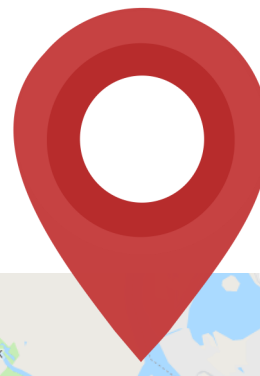
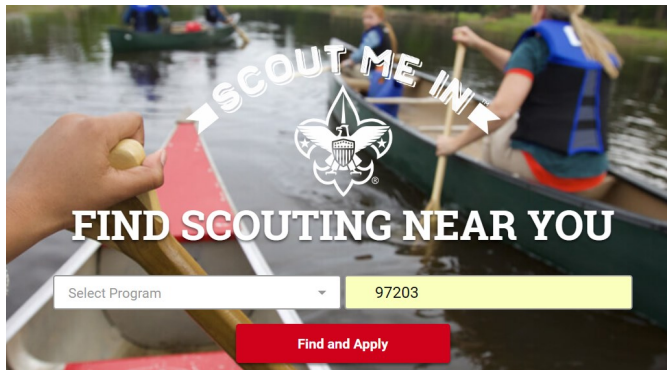


# How to Set Up Your BeAScout Pin



BeAScout.org is the first place many families go to look for a Scout group to join. To make the most out of recruitment, make sure your unit's pin is up to date and ready for online applications.



- First**, see what your pin looks like by going to BeAScout.org and typing your zip code. You'll see a list view, which you can change to a map to see the pins.
- Next**, go to my.scouting.org (committee chair, unit leader, or chartered org rep) to update the details. Under **Legacy Web Tools**, select **BeAScout**.
- Make sure Pin Mode is set to **Unit** • Set Pin Status to **Active** • We recommend setting Apply Status to **Active** so Scouts can apply online.
  - Update the information with current contacts and a quick blurb about your unit.
  - Don't forget to click **Save** at the end.

## Family Scouting-Update Pin to Welcome Girls

In order for a pack to indicate that they welcome girls, the **chartered organization representative** needs to go to their my.scouting.org site and open **Organization Manager**.



Once there, click **Settings**, then opt in to Family Scouting. Finally, select whether the pack will have girls, boys, or both.
